

OSPREY FISHING GAME (For two players)

Getting started

Choose an osprey each **03(97)** or **33(11)**

1. Each player needs game sheet. This has two maps of Rutland water with a grid.
2. The top is Your Osprey map and the bottom one is the Competing Osprey map.

On the Player map

3. Each player has 10 fish each of which will be drawn in as a cross.
4. In secret, so no one else can see, put 10 crosses on the BOTTOM map in Rutland water (not on land)
5. Keep your map and fish location hidden so the other players cannot see!

How to play

The order of play is as follows.....

1. The first player chooses a square to fish on their blank Your Osprey map. They give the **co-ordinate** of the square, letter first number second eg. **A 5**
2. The opponent looks at their bottom map showing their fish and finds the co-ordinate and says...

“CATCH” - a fish with a square in it

“NEAR MISS” – a fish found within one square of the chosen square

“MISS” – no fish within one square of the chosen square

3. The first player marks the result on their “Your Osprey” map

CATCH	X
NEAR MISS	+
MISS	O

4. It is now the turn of the second player to choose a square to fish. Follow 1-3 above.

Who is the best at fishing 03(97) or 33(11)?

The first player to catch 5 fish is the winner.
