

Leicestershire and Rutland Wildlife Trust Photography Competition 2022 Terms and Conditions

• The competition begins 1st June 2022 and will close on 30th June 2022

• Winners name and entry may feature in our publications and may feature in our Wild Magazine, Leicestershire and Rutland Wildlife Trust Facebook, Twitter and Instagram accounts, the home page of the Leicestershire and Rutland Wildlife Trust website and email mailings

• Winner will receive a prize of any Leicestershire and Rutland Wildlife Trust membership of their choice, this includes Individual, Joint, Family membership which will be valid for one year.

- Membership cannot be exchanged for a cash alternative
- LRWT members are permitted to take part in the competition

• Current LRWT members prize will depend on how they pay for membership, if member pays monthly by direct debit, they will get 12 months free from the their next payment month and if they pay annually, they will get the next year free from their annual renewal date

- Winners will be notified within 10 days of the competition end date
- Leicestershire & Rutland Wildlife Trust takes no liability of prizes being lost or damaged in transit
- One photo to be entered per person
- Photo must have been taken in Leicestershire and Rutland to showcase local wildlife and wild places

• Can be taken on any camera including a phone but must be submitted in digital format via our email <u>info@lrwt.org.uk</u>

• Entrants must not be professional photographers and, for the purposes of this competition, a professional photographer will be considered to be someone who makes more than half their annual income from the sale of their photographs.

• Judges will be looking for 'natural' images so photographs may be digitally enhanced to remove spots or blemishes, crop or brighten the image, but not excessively manipulated or using any post camera effects.

• The judges reserve the right to exclude any image they believe may have been excessively treated so as to alter its authenticity.

• All entries must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party.

• The entrants must be the sole owner in all photographs entered and must have obtained permission of any people featured in the entries or their parents/guardians if children under 16 are featured.
